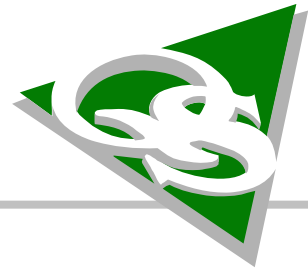

CETA ADMINISTRATION

It has come to our attention that the Minister for Higher Education and Training has given notice of his intention, in terms of the powers entrusted to him in terms of section 15(1) of the Act, to appoint an Administrator to function on behalf of CETA, as set out in the letter, due to the fact that there is sufficient evidence that the CETA fails to properly perform its functions in terms of section 10 of the Act and its Constitution.

The Association of South African Quantity Surveyors (ASAQS) wishes to record its support for the recommendation that CETA be placed under administration. This position is taken by the ASAQS in the hope and belief that such action will assist to unlock the full potential of CETA to effectively serve the training needs of the construction sector. In supporting this initiative, the ASAQS also pledges to support and collaborate fully with the appointed administrator.

ASAQS is a signatory to the letter from certain established employer bodies to the Minister of Education and Training dealing with this particular matter. This letter clearly sets out the grounds for this position.

We would request that this letter be tabled for consideration at the CETA Council meeting scheduled for Wednesday 9 June 2010.
